EDENBRIDGE HOSPITAL

An appeal was launched in the 1920's to build a War Memorial Hospital.

The community threw themselves into raising money, and in 1931 the Hospital was opened.

In 1957 the League of Friends was formed, and has spent over £1 million on capital works, in providing equipment, and refurbishing the Hospital. Donations in kind, time, and money are used to pay for items for which the NHS is unable to pay.

Between 2006 and 2008 the League fought a long and successful campaign to retain both the Hospital and our Minor Injuries Unit.

Since the advent of the NHS there have been many changes, but the Hospital still provides wonderful care for the people of Edenbridge and the surrounding villages.

The next few years will see major changes in the way medical care is delivered. With your support the Hospital will be adapted to meet the challenges which lie ahead.
